Message Title: Succession Plans

Text: Judges 2

Read Judges chapter 2

Why do you think faith is on the decline in NZ? Do you see hope for the future? What do you think is needed?

Have you had any experience mentoring or being mentored (outside of your family)? Share these experiences, and the impact they have had on you.

In what ways could we start to, or improve on, mentoring younger Christians?

Can you think of any other methods God has provided for passing faith down from generation to generation?
