



## Judges Series Study Sheet

Week 7—May 26

Message Title: Trumpets and Jars

Text: Judges 7

Read Judges chapter 7.

Imagine that you are Gideon, after God had whittled down his troops to 300. What would you be thinking? What would you be feeling?

Why does God place Gideon and his men in such a position of weakness (see v2)?

Share honestly about a time you have experienced weakness in your life. What was it like emotionally, mentally, physically, spiritually?

Have you seen God working in your life through times of weakness? Talk about what he has shown you personally through those times.

What have you noticed about yourself during times of struggle and weakness that you otherwise would not have seen?

Talk about the times in your life when you have experienced the greatest spiritual growth. What were the factors that led to that growth? Were those times of strength or weakness in your life?

Can you honestly say, “when I am weak, then I am strong”? (2 Cor 12:10). What does that mean? Have you experienced it?

Do you know somebody who is going through a time of weakness at the moment? How can you support them in their struggle?

What practical steps can you personally take to be more attentive to what God is doing in times of weakness in your life?

Spend time praying for those who are experiencing weakness, suffering and pain at the moment—those in your group, in our church, our communities and our world.
